Profile:

My background experience is from working in Primary schools of varying sizes. My career started in a 9-13, 600 pupil Junior High School in Hull, a class teacher also teaching French to 9-11 year olds, as well as drama and PE to 9-13 year olds. I then worked in a Hull Primary school for 13 years, my key responsibilities being integrated studies with thematic planning and SENco. I also spent two years as acting deputy and acting headteacher. I then spent five years at a Primary School just outside Middlesbrough as assistant headteacher, teaching Years 5/6 with responsibility for English.
