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## News from the Classes

This week **KS1** have been focussing on addition in Maths and have been exploring the relationship between addition and subtraction. In English we have been inventing a new part of our story “Small Knight and George” and came up with some great ideas.

**KS2:** In Maths we have been looking at getting the correct change. This is a really important life skill as there is a big difference between 1p and £10. You wouldn't want to get that muddled up! Do get the children to help with money/change at home as this all helps with their learning.

In English there has been a big push on looking at our sentence types in writing. This is a way of helping the children to use a variety of sentences and to ensure they use their age appropriate grammar. There have been a few changes to the 1 → 20 sentences so it was important we learnt the new ones quickly. In the last writing target review, many children set the target to use more sentence types so we are already on the way to achieving it.

Well done to Oscar W, Josh, Hattie, James, Effie and Ned who represented the school at the Primary Cross County event on a lovely afternoon yesterday. Special mention must go to our 2, Year 3 pupils who raced against older year 4 pupils – Ned finished 10<sup>th</sup> and Effie 13<sup>th</sup>.
